Uses



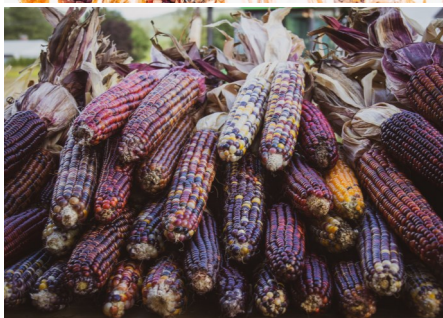
- Decorative and Ornamental Products (especially in autumn)
