- Oats are a cereal crop that belong to the grass family.
- Oats grow quickly, usually reaching maturity in around sixty days, and they grow well in poor soil conditions.
- On average, oats produce 65.1 bushels per acre in the United States. South Dakota and Minnesota are the nations highest producers.
