About Popcorn

- Popcorn is a member of the grass family whose hard kernels can be popped when heated.
- Popcorn is ready to harvest in 90-120 days (depending on the variety).
- Less than 1% of the corn grown in the United States is popcorn.
- A small amount of water that expands as it is heated is what causes popcorn kernels to pop.

- Popcorn is Illinois' official state snack food.
- Each year, Americans consume 16 billion quarts of popped popcorn.
- Nebraska produces around one fourth of all popcorn produced in the U.S.
